Latest Statistics

- **94.5**% increase projected in ORC Crimes by the end of 2023 (on track to nearly double from 2022)
- □ \$112.1 billion in loss Avg shrink rate increased 1.6% in 2022
- ☐ 76.5% Retailers who have seen an increase in ORC
- □ 67% Increased in associated violence in 2023

On average, retailers attribute 65% of retail shrink to external crime, including ORC.




What's fueling growth of ORC?

- Opioid epidemic continues

Organized retail crime remains widespread and has become an increasingly urgent problem for retailers.






The 3SI Law Enforcement Division (LED)

- □ Comprised of retired career Law Enforcement professionals with over 642 combined years of crime fighting experience between 26 LED leaders.
- □ Trains new agencies, and offers refresher training as needed, on comprehensive Law Enforcement tactical live GPS response on the 3SI Tracking platform.
- □ Partners consult with agencies on active cases to leverage tracking technology with critical evidence to advance cases and close patterns of crime.

The 3SI Law Enforcement Division (LED)

- □ Consults with agencies during active tracks and assists with the interpretation of track data and using the handheld RF Beacon deployment.
- □ After every 3SI tracking event, LED talks with the agency to address weaknesses and reward exceptional performance.
- □Support Detectives post-event to interpret data, assist with preparing search warrant affidavits, provide tracking information and testify in Court to explain the 3SI tracking system to the Court.



Why California Tops the List

2011 – Assembly Bill 109: Public Safety Realignment Act (Deconstruction of CA's prison system)


- Qualifying convictions/sentences carried out at county vs. state level
- Supervised release included as an option

2014 - Proposition 47: Safe Neighborhoods and Schools Act

- Restructured the crime of grand theft from \$400 to \$950
- Elimination of California Penal Code Section 666 (Petty Theft with Priors)
- Reclassification of personal use drug offenses from felony to misdemeanor

2016 - Proposition 57: Criminal Sentences & Juvenile Crime Proceedings

• Early release for non-violent offenders



The Results of Problematic Legislation

- Rapid increase in property crime
- Emboldened criminal activity
- Lack of prosecution
- Lack of appropriate sentencing
- Criminal enterprise sophistication
- Crimes against persons predictably increased
- Retailers sustaining immeasurable loss

California signs Assembly Bill 331

AB 331 will allow the task force to:

- ☐ Collaborate with allied law enforcement agencies and district attorneys to identify and prosecute organized theft rings, recover lost merchandise and reduce associated crime.
- ☐ Collaborate with the retail industry to reduce incidents of theft and strengthen locational safety for shoppers.
- ☐ Launch a web-based portal for the public and California retailers to report tips directly to the CHP.
- ☐ Continue to partner with allied agencies to offer specialized training and general law enforcement assistance related to auto theft and organized retail crimes.











Beauty Store – Robbery– October 30, 2023 **Crime Cycle Stopped**

- Location: Indianapolis, IN
- EVENT SUMMARY:
 - ➤ Two suspects exited a beauty store with over a dozen unpaid items, one of which was equipped with an ORC Tracker[™] that alerted 3SI and the police.
 - Within an hour, police stopped and apprehended the suspects.
 - A full investigation led to the discovery of 269 additional stolen items from various stores.
 - ➤ All recovered stolen goods amounted to a value over \$10,000.



Beauty Store – Robbery– October 30, 2023 **Crime Cycle Stopped**

- Location: Indianapolis, IN
- EVENT SUMMARY (continued):
 - > All stolen items were taken into evidence by the police.
 - The suspects have been apprehended and all assets fully recovered.



Telecommunications Store – ORC Ring - September 25, 2023

Location: Opelika, AL

- EVENT SUMMARY:
 - ➤ ORC thieves entered a Telecommunications Store and took multiple items along with a Phone Tracker[™] Device.
 - Organized Retail Crime (ORC) group intercepted by officers after tracking them to another town in Alabama.
 - Stolen goods from various retailers found in suspects' vehicle.
 - Incriminating items like credit card skimmers, breaker boxes, and counterfeit driver's licenses discovered

Telecommunications Store – ORC Ring - September 25, 2023

Location: Opelika, AL


- EVENT SUMMARY (continued):
 - Swift detention and arrest of the suspects.
 - Investigation Outcome: Culprits found to have targeted stores along the coast.
 - Full recovery \$30,000, 3 arrests plus...
 - ➤ 14 significant felony theft cases resolved thanks to 3Sl's tracking and law enforcement.

Beauty Store – Robbery– February 15, 2023**Robbery Tied to Major ORC Gang**

Location: Dublin, CA

■ EVENT SUMMARY:

- ➤ Three suspects entered a beauty store and stole approximately \$1500 worth of merchandise, including an **ORC Tracker**TM, then fled the store.
- Local police responded to the crime and tracked the suspect vehicle to an address in Oakland. Together with local Organized Retail Crime detectives, they obtained a search warrant.
- Law Enforcement recovered a loaded assault rifle, detained two men and one woman, and recovered over \$250,000 in stolen inventory from the beauty store as well as other stores, including a popular apparel store.



GPS Best Practices to Fight ORC

- Utilize Covert GPS technology as part of your overall store security philosophy
- Don't chase ORC events
 - It's one gang today and a new one tomorrow
- Be prepared by being ready
- Once you deploy in your store, reach out to local PD
 - Builds stronger community relationships and teamwork
 - PD recognizes that GPS helps them stay safe tactical high ground + situational awareness
 - Keeps store staff safe by getting perpetrators out of store and into hands of police

Philadelphia looting 2023: 72 charged after several stores ransacked across city, DA's office says



PHILADELPHIA (CBS) -- Seventy-two people have been charged after <u>several stores</u> were looted across

<u>Philadelphia last week.</u> Philadelphia officials, including District Attorney Larry Krasner, gave an update Monday regarding the civil unrest.


<u>Business owners have been left to pick up the pieces</u> nearly a week after swarms of thieves looted retailers Tuesday night.


The chaos started hours after a judge dismissed all charges against a former police officer who shot and killed <u>Eddie Irizarry</u>. However, police have said that none of the looters were connected to the peaceful protesters who came out in support of Irizarry.

One video shows police and alleged looters clashing outside the Lululemon store on Walnut. Then, just down the street, a security guard tried to hold off people forcing their way into the Apple Store. Sporting goods stores, a Foot Locker, a GameStop, a <u>medical marijuana dispensary</u> and <u>a streetwear business were also among the shops</u> - <u>hit</u>.

<u>Dollar store, Electronic Game Store</u>, and <u>Pharmacy</u> – Philadelphia, PA – September 27 20+ arrests

The recent riot and looting incidents in Philadelphia were a source of great fear and danger for business owners and innocent bystanders. Over 200 individuals participated, resulting in numerous retailers being targeted. During a critical time, 3Sl's technology played a **crucial role**. By providing police with real-time intelligence from covert GPS devices, which looters unknowingly took, they significantly assisted law enforcement's response. Moreover, this real-time data facilitated immediate interventions and served as a tool for subsequent event analysis. Due to the joint efforts of the police and the invaluable assistance of 3Sl, more than **20** arrests were made, weapons were seized, and stolen goods from retailers were recovered. This collaboration underscores 3Sl's commitment to a safer community, highlighting how collective action can combat disruptions and restore security. **#SaferWorld**
